In that short time, the poets blew me away with their creativity, their playfulness, their wisdom, and their generosity with themselves and with each other. This generosity is exemplified in lines from Julia F.'s poem, "Imagination Me":

And I watched them celebrate themselves: their hearts, their minds, and their seemingly endless imaginations. Week by week, their confidence grew and their poetic voices blossomed.

It is my sincere hope that they all continue to write poetry after I've left, because the world needs more voices like those of the EVCS poets. I'll turn it over, now, to Isabella C., who, in "Nice Poetry," summarizes my thoughts on poetry more beautifully than I can:
